

The rights set out in the Act respecting health services and social services (LSSSS)

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- **Right** to information
- **Right** to receive services 2.
- Right to choose a professional or institution 3.
- **Right** to receive appropriate care according 4. to one's health status
- Right to consent to care or to refuse care 5.
- **Right** to actively participate in decision-making 6.
- Right to be accompanied, assisted and represented 7.
- Right to shelter/accommodation 8. **Right** to receive services in English 9. Right to access one's User's file 10. Right to the confidentiality of one's User's file 11. Right to lodge a complaint 12.

The LSSSS builds on the fundamental rights in order to define the users' rights. Other rights are recognized by the Quebec Charter of Human Rights and Freedoms and the Quebec Civil Code. Theses rights are applicable everywhere including to the Health and Social Services institutions.
